1. The Government of Grenada has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the OECS Regional Health Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for the Procurement of Ambulances, and Emergency Response Vehicles.
2. The Ministry of Finance now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the Procurement of Ambulances, and Emergency Response Vehicles. as per the specifications and quantities outlined in the Bidding Document.
3. Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers – "July 2016, Revised November 2017 and August 2018 ("Procurement Regulations") and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
4. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from The Acting Chief Procurement Officer, Central Procurement Unit, Ministry of Finance - spo@procurement.gov.gd and request a copy of the bidding documents during office hours 8:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. for inspection.
5. The bidding document in English may be Issued to interested Bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address .The document will be sent by E-mail.
6. Bidders are to submit their Bids with password protection via e-mail to address cpu@gov.gd by bid submission deadline **June 02, 2023 at 2:00 p.m.**

Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at address (1) below or using conferencing facilities (2) as specified below on June 02, 2023 at 3:00pm.

All files submitted should be clearly labelled bid for the Procurement of Ambulances, and Emergency Response Vehicles. The name of the firm should also be clearly stated. All firms should submit their passwords for the bids to the email address stated above within 1 hour after the bid submission deadline.

7. All bids must be accompanied by a bid securing declaration.

8. Attention is drawn to the Procurement Regulations requiring the Borrower to disclose information on the successful bidder's beneficial ownership, as part of the Contract Award Notice, using the Beneficial Ownership Disclosure Form as included in the bidding document.
